Design your crest with the colours and symbols that best define you as a classroom group and as a team. **Here is an example:**

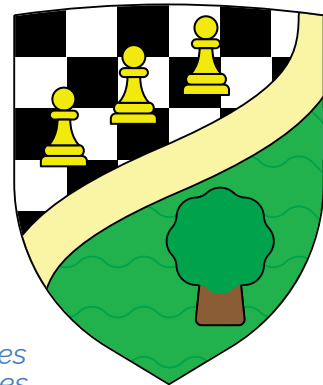
COAT OF ARMS REPRESENTING THE VALUES OF THIS TEAM AND THE ACTIVITY
